

2011 Cecil County Jr. Dragster Program

Race Amendments

Gates will open @ 7AM for Jr. Dragster Entrance (Sunday only)

1st Round Runner-ups: \$10 - 2nd All age bracket race (no points) on Sundays. Trophy to winner.

Bonus Points Days: The 1st age group race at each event Apr 9th, May 28th & June 18th will be counted towards 2011 Jr. Dragster Points Program.

Calcutta: During our Bonus Points Days (Apr 9th, May 28th & June 18th & Oct 15th) there will be a "Calcutta", which means you pay \$10 in the staging lines before 1st round of eliminations. Points will be tabulated for any and all races you enter that day and the Jr. racer who receives that most amount of accumulated points for the day, will receive all of the "Calcutta" money collected.

330 Jr. Outlaw Races: *Sponsored by Hoopes Fire Prevention & Kaspers Certified Auto & Performance.* There will be a 330 Jr. Outlaw Race at each of the Saturday Night Street Car Shootout races on April 2nd, July 2nd, September 3rd and November 5th. Entrance fee is \$35. Winner receives Trophy & \$100. This is .400 Pro-Tree, heads-up, 400lb weight minimum, 8 car qualifying field (4.10 is the E.T. limit per NHRA). This is on a Pro Ladder. You must be 13 yrs. old and have a Jr. License. (These races have been added in an attempt to expose spectators to Jr. Drag Racing. You may be racing after dark.) This will also include the 2nd Annual Yellow Bullet Nationals. \$50- for first perfect light of each of the four races. (This will be progressive if there is not a perfect light; it carries to the next race.) \$50- Lowest E>T. of event.

On April 30th, June 4th & October 1st, will be the Northeast Junior Outlaw Series. Entry fee-\$75 Winner \$500, Runner-up \$250 & \$125 Semi's. Payout based on 16 car qualified field. Please visit their website @ www.northeastjunioroutlaw.com for rules and additional information.

Top Jr. Dragster: *Sponsored by Lightning Chassis/Monster Racing Block-* \$25 entrance fee. This will be a four race points series held on Apr 9th, May 28th, June 18th & Oct 15th. Winner at each event receives a Trophy & \$100. Points champion will be rewarded a Championship Trophy and \$500 Savings Bond at the Jr. Banquet. This is a 330 bracket race with a 4.70 qualifying field. Field will be limited to an odd # of racers, #1 qualifier receiving 1st round bye. (4.10 is the E.T. limit per NHRA). One qualifying run. Lane choice goes to fastest dial each round. Sportsman Ladder.

Jr. Points Raffle: All racers who sign up for the points program will be eligible for two raffles. Each tech card you complete will be put into the barrel. Before the Eastern Conference Finals, 5 names will be pulled. Each name that is pulled and that races @ the ECF for Team Cecil County will receive a check from the C.C. Jr. Fund for \$100. Before the Jr. Divisional @ Mason Dixon, another 5 names will be pulled. Each name that is pulled and that races @ Divisional for Cecil County, will receive a check from the C.C. Jr. Fund for \$100.

(Any race that you enter @ Cecil; Sundays, Bonus Points, and Street Car Shootout are eligible)

Any Jr. Class that does not have an 8 car field, the classes will be blended into one. The younger class will be called to the lanes first in an attempt to have them run each other. The older group will be called to the lanes. It is random pairing for 1st round. This may mean that you will be called to 4 separate lanes and pulled at random.
